Domestic Violence Issues - economic justice and affordable housing are super important to keep in mind

National Low Income Housing coalition, Women's Law Center - webinar stressed Oppose AND Propose, find out the pet issues of the representatives so you can bring your issue in WITH their issues. Some of the discoveries in the survey - don't talk about how someone is wrong, but emphasize that Trump is marching in lockstep with the GOP, not making up his own mind about anything. He is NOT outside the system. Don't use terms like "safety net", use terms like basic living standards. Focus on violated promises. Tuesday 5/23 is supposed to be announcement of budget proposals - elimination of affordable housing (something he has promised not to do). Bringing up a personal story - must "build a landscape" around the story, ex. give the details behind a woman's domestic violence experience, like why she can't get a job/childcare.
